













QUESTION EIGHTEEN – Suggestions

We asked respondents to suggest further ways in which SIGN could support trainees, and received responses which could be grouped into themes as follows: electronic alerts for new publications, providing more guidelines on different topics, in particular dentistry topics, provide materials in hard copy formats.
